 - D. *May 17, 2022 - MUNICIPAL PRIMARY.
County employees are all stepping up again to keep contracted labor at the lowest cost, and ensure machines are delivered and to help scan the mail-in ballots.
 - E. *May 18, 2022 is the first day to REGISTER after primary.*
 - F. *May 24, 2022 is the last day for County Board of Elections to receive voted military and overseas absentee ballots (submitted for delivery no later than 11:59 P.M. on May 16, 2022).*
 - G. *Mail-in/Absentee ballots have been transmitted to voters.
Received them 4/25/2022 and had about 4,000 of them out by 4/29/2022.

*Northumberland County is entirely in the 9th Congressional District, currently served by Dan Meuser (R).
Our state representation has shifted, and the 108th has shifted towards Montour County and covers northern Northumberland County. While 107th covers the southern half and parts of Schuylkill County.
