
ORDER

AND NOW, this 25th day of May, 2021, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the protocol to be followed in the Court House and Court Offices, effective June 1, 2021 shall hereafter be as follows:

1. All persons within the courthouse shall wear masks in public areas.
2. Any court employee who is fully vaccinated may remove their mask in their personal work area; otherwise, if not vaccinated, a court employee must wear a mask at all times.
3. It is discretionary with the Presiding Judge or the Magisterial District Judge whether fully vaccinated individuals may remove their masks in their court rooms.
4. If an individual is feeling ill or exhibiting any symptoms of COVID-19, they are to contact the office which they have a scheduled matter for how to proceed with any rescheduling.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Order shall be posted on the Court House entrance, the doors of each court room, and shall be made available on the County and Court website, and published in the Northumberland County Legal Journal.
